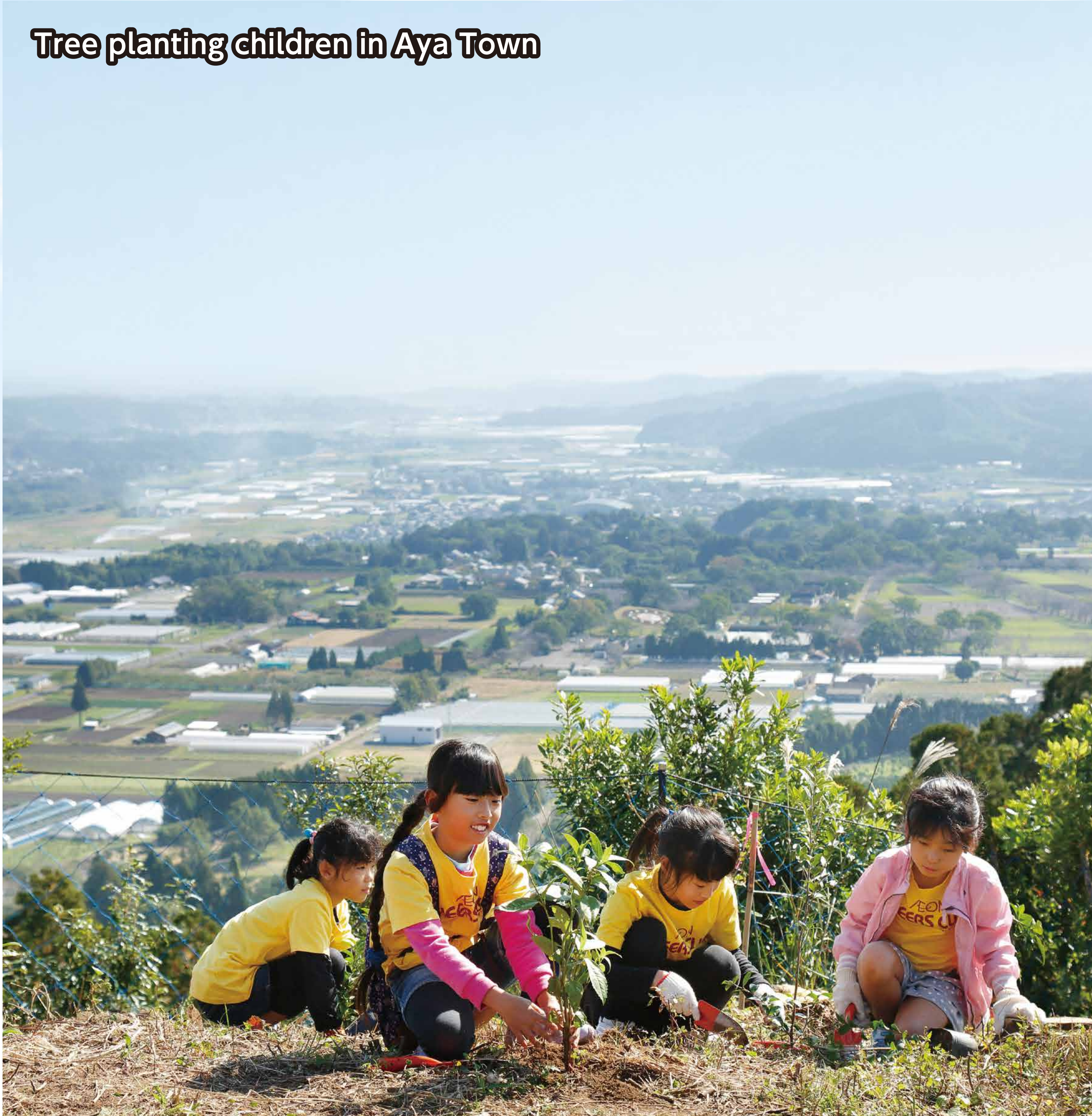
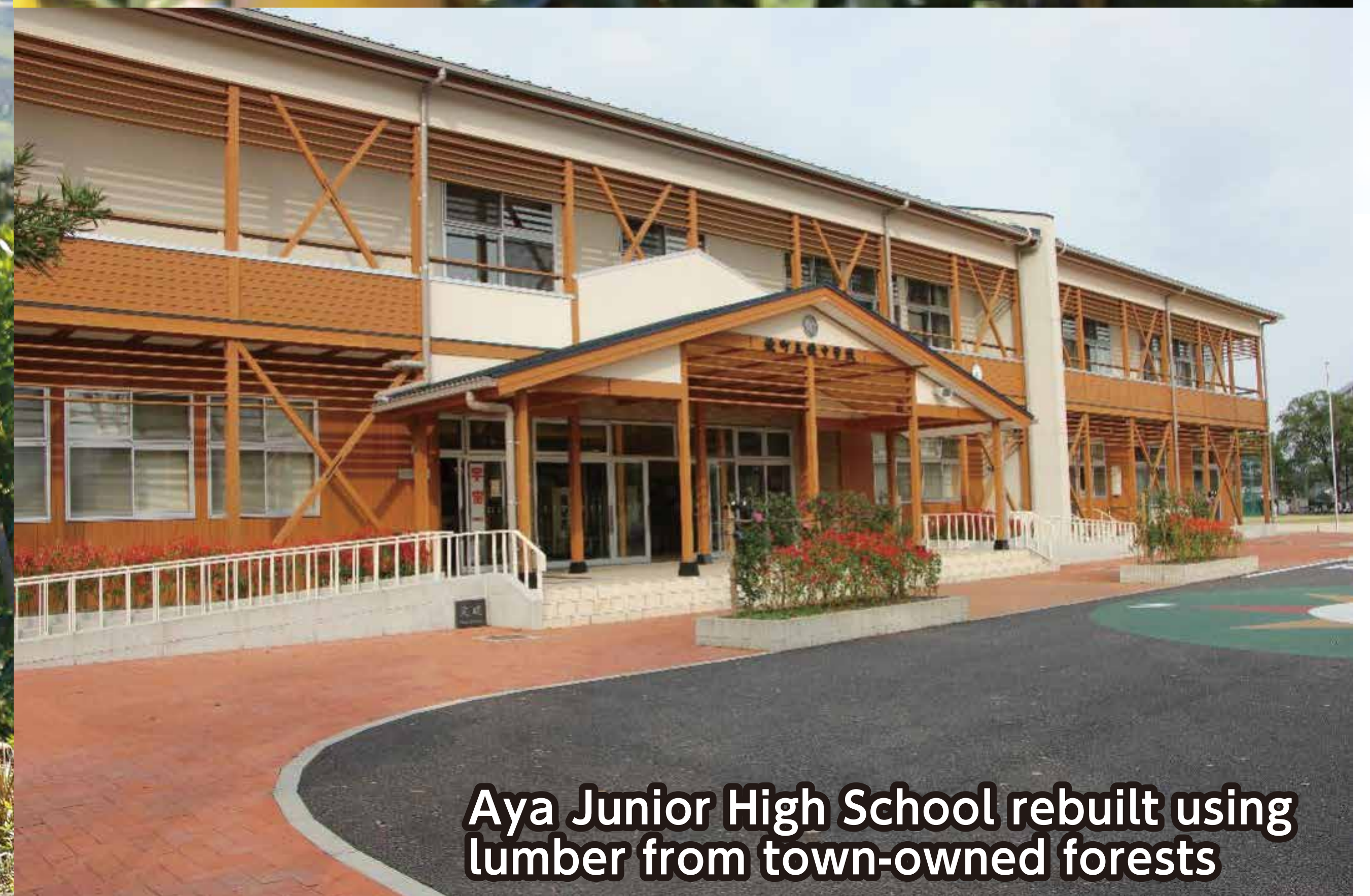

Tree planting children in Aya Town

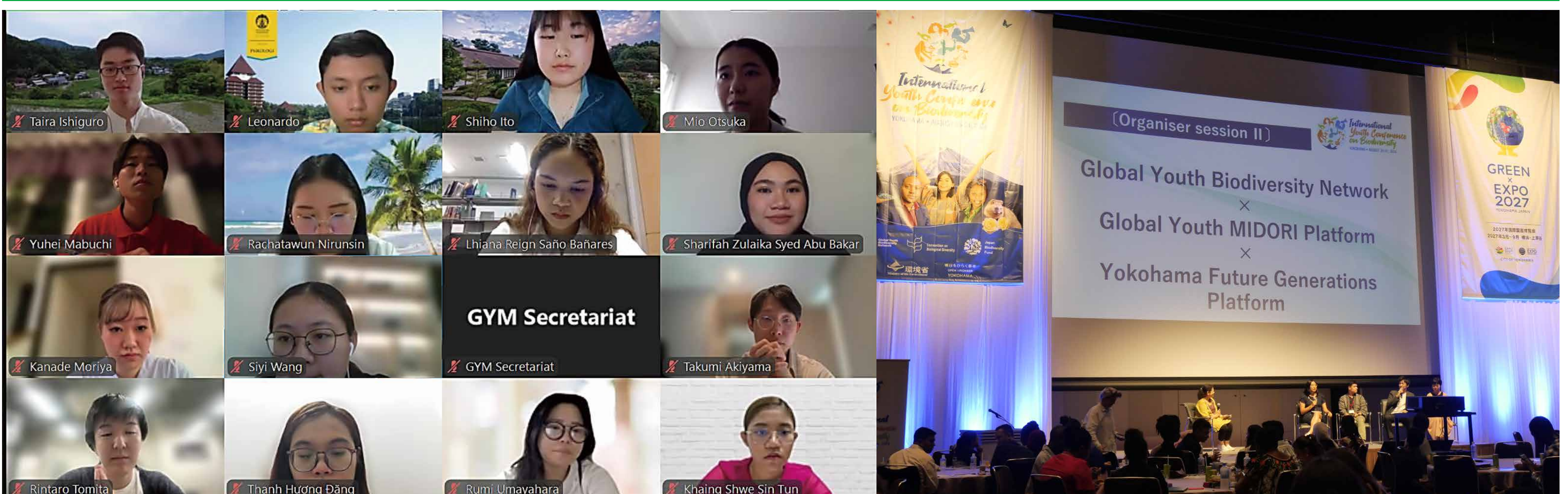


Tree-planting had a ripple effect on an increase in the number of honeybees pollinating Hyuganatsu citrus

SATOYAMA: Bringing Biodiversity Conservation to Life Through our new SATOYAMA initiative, AEON Environmental Foundation is working towards the realization of biodiversity and a sustainable society. A shining example of this effort is our work in Aya Town, a UNESCO Biosphere Reserve, where nature and community thrive together.



The Global Youth MIDORI platform (GYM): A collaborative project launched in 2024 by United Nations University Institute for the Advanced Study of Sustainability (UNU-IAS) and the Foundation to empower young people to address biodiversity issues. The top two winners of the speech contest held during the first international joint training program will participate in an official side event at COP16, discussing the expansion of youth participation in policy-making and the importance of sustainable systems.
